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Goals of the Distributor Channel

- Market transformation work toward changing what customers are asking for
- Promote very high efficiency equipment and emerging technologies
- Help contractors gain the technical skills needed to install these technologies
- Provide sales training for contractors so they can speak to the features and benefits of these equipment types

Equipment in the Distributor Channel

- Equipment Types:
 - 18+ SEER ASHP
 - 18+ SEER CAC
 - 19+ Ductless ACs and ASHPs
 - Eligible smart thermostats installed with these systems
- These equipment types will no longer be eligible for rebates in the traditional channel

SEER ratings are based on AHRI certificates of equipment combinations.



How Does a Dealer Participate?

First, talk to your distributor to make sure they are participating and get the rebate chart. They may also have a list of their equipment combinations that qualify for the rebates.

Project Steps:

- 1. Install qualified equipment
- 2. Collect required data (see data collection form)
- 3. Submit project on the OIT with required documentation:
 - Customer Invoice
 - Acknowledgement Form signed by customer
- 4. Resolve flaws, if any, via the OIT
- 5. Receive rebate reimbursement from distributor



Application Flow in Distributor Channel


Customer purchases qualifying equipment and receives instant rebate

The OIT (online intake tool) is the website that contractors currently use to submit applications

Contractor submits application on OIT



Program provides rebate funds to distributor





What Needs to be on the Invoice to the Customer?

- Ameren Missouri Customer Name must match Ameren Missouri Account Holder (on utility bill)
- Installation address must match associated Ameren Missouri Account
- Model and serial numbers of all rebated equipment, including eligible smart thermostats
- If a furnace or air handler is included in the AHRI, it must be listed on the invoice (including Existing Furnaces)
- A non-redacted rebate amount that is passed on to the customer and is identified as the "Ameren Missouri Instant Rebate"

Accessing the OIT

- Visit the OIT website (partner-oit.com)
- There will be two options:
 - Traditional Channel
 - Distributor Channel
- You will use your existing username and password for both sites

Rebate Eligibility

- Distributor channel rebates are effective for installations on and after May 1, 2020.
- Customer and equipment eligibility are the same as for the traditional rebate channel. Key points include:
 - Customer Eligibility
 - Residential Ameren Missouri account
 - Single family and multi-family are eligible
 - Equipment Eligibility
 - AHRI rated and meet requirements on rebate chart
 - Rebate amounts are based on SEER and equipment replaced
 - Replacement/retrofit and new construction projects





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
